

As all books written by Carole Marsh, this is another good book to read. It's enjoyable and it is worth 3 points if your child is participating in the Accelerated Reading Program. The reading level was 5.1 (5th grade 1 month). It was interesting enough and simple enough for my 4th grader and at the same time, it did introduce a couple new vocabulary words (which is always good). I recommend all books by Carol Marsh, due to the realistic fiction, both educational and enjoyable.

My daughter loves this series. She read them the first time at age 6 and is rereading them again at age 9. The mysteries are based upon real locations that children can relate to. These can sometimes be hard to find at the local libraries so I would highly recommend adding this series to your personal library.
