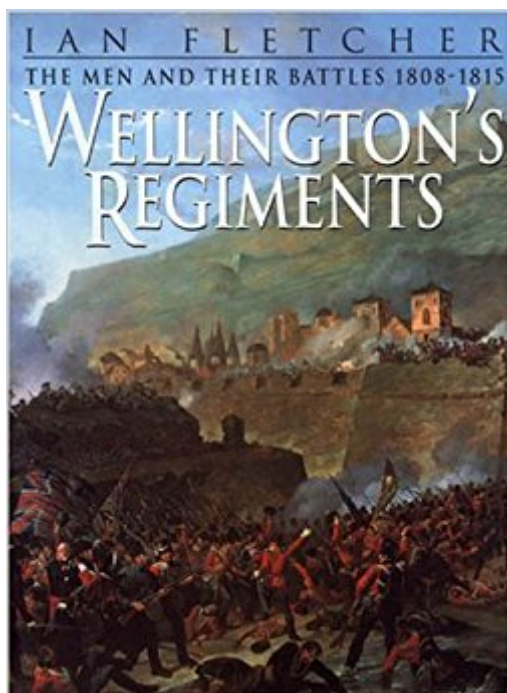


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Wellington's Regiments : The Men And Their Battles 1808-1815
