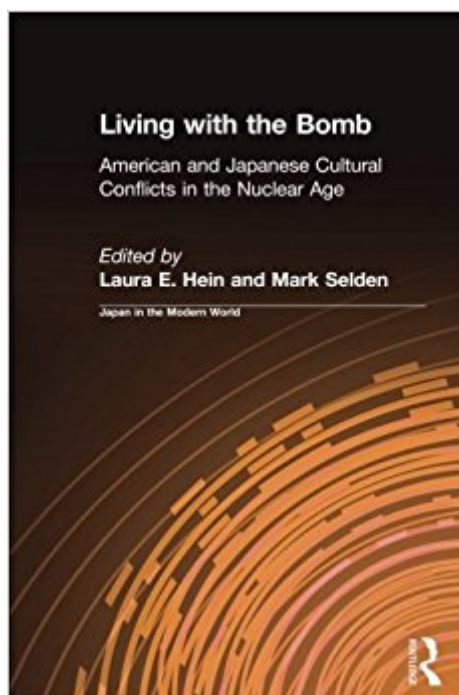


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Living With The Bomb: American And Japanese Cultural Conflicts In The Nuclear Age (Japan In The Modern World)

The development and use of the atomic bombs at Hiroshima and Nagasaki number among the formative national experiences for both Japanese and Americans as well as for 20th-century Japan-US relations. This volume explores the way in which the bomb has shaped the self-image of both peoples.

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I purchased this book for a Japanese History class and absolutely loved it. Living with the Bomb covers the 1995 remembrance of the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki from as many points of view as it possibly can. It covers the Japanese, American, and Korean perspectives as well as the perspectives of Japanese-Americans and Hibakusha (the bomb survivors). It covers many subjects including the 1995 memorial exhibit at the Smithsonian and the censorship it faced, the Hiroshima Peace Park and other places of remembrance in Japan, the way victims of the bomb were treated in their respective countries, and much more. Each chapter is written by a different author and can stand on its own. I enjoyed this book so much that I lent it to my grandmother, who also loved it and found it very informative. She has since recommended it to other family members. If you are

interested in many cultural and political controversies that still surrounded the bombings in 1995, this is a great book for you!

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
