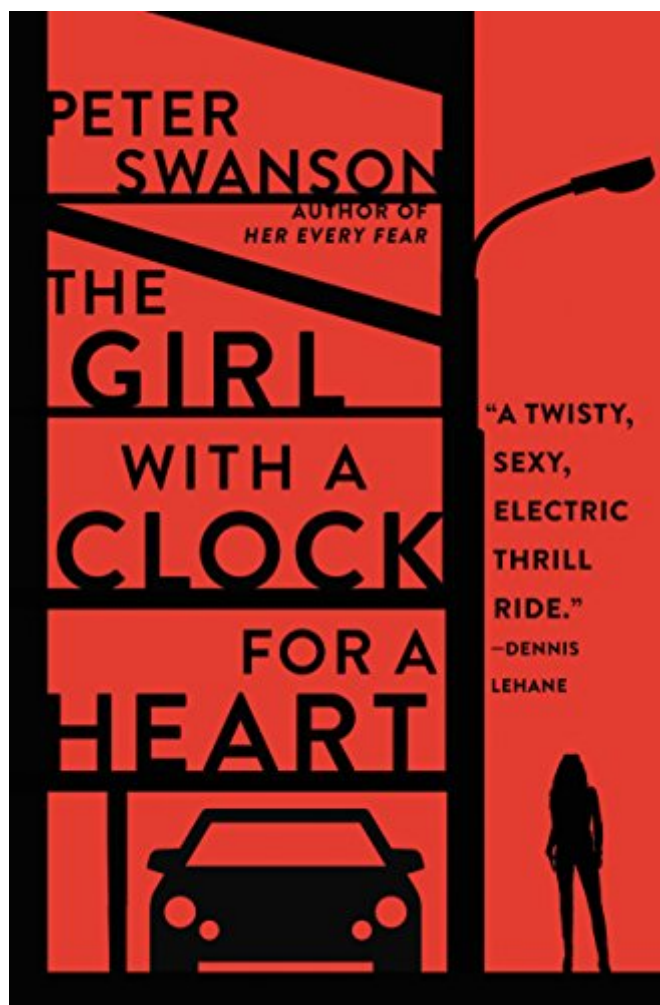

Probably the most enjoyable book I bought and read in a long long time. so I decided to get his previous work " The Girl with a clock for a heart" Whereas it may not be in the same level as the previous one, it's still extremely satisfying and worth the read.

It's very rare when I find a book that I can't put down. I read this in 2 days, it was that compelling. Peter Swanson's writing is so taut, the storyline so engaging, that the next time I start one of his books, I'll have to make sure I have nothing I have to get done. He's already made himself one of my favorite writers! A superbly written thriller!

I had read "The Kind Worth Killing" earlier in the summer and loved it so thought I'd read the other book by this author and loved it as well! It reminded me of the '80s movie "Body Heat" in that it had some clever twists (didn't surprise me as much as "Killing" probably b/c I saw Body Heat about 20 times). Regardless, I really like this writer's voice and the twists and turns in his stories. I found it interesting that the book jumped back and forth between the past and present of the main character in order to develop the connection between George and (my Kindle keeps correcting her name and changing it to "loan" so I give up...

I should have read readers' reviews (not reviews from other authors) before downloading this book. Peter Swanson had great ideas for a plot that did not evolve in this book. The lack of suspense plus repetitive recounting of the events was tiresome and ineffective. I thought the end was a cheap trick or just missing when the book abruptly ended. Is this inexperience or just rush to print? George was naïve, and he never grew as character. Did he have a death wish or just stupid? Liana would have given him what he deserved - a quick death to tie up her loose ends. Does he have a fatal attraction? The reader/plot needs resolution No more Peter Swanson books; back to reading Michael Connelly or even John Grisham.
