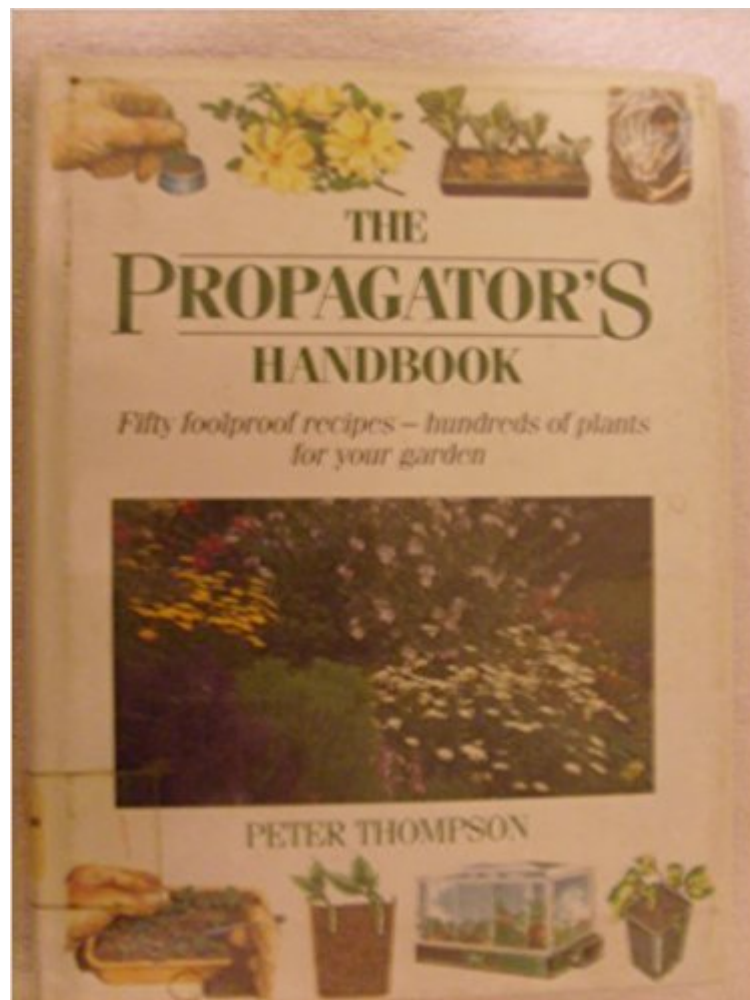




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The Propagator's Handbook: Fifty Foolproof Recipes, Hundreds Of Plants For Your Garden
