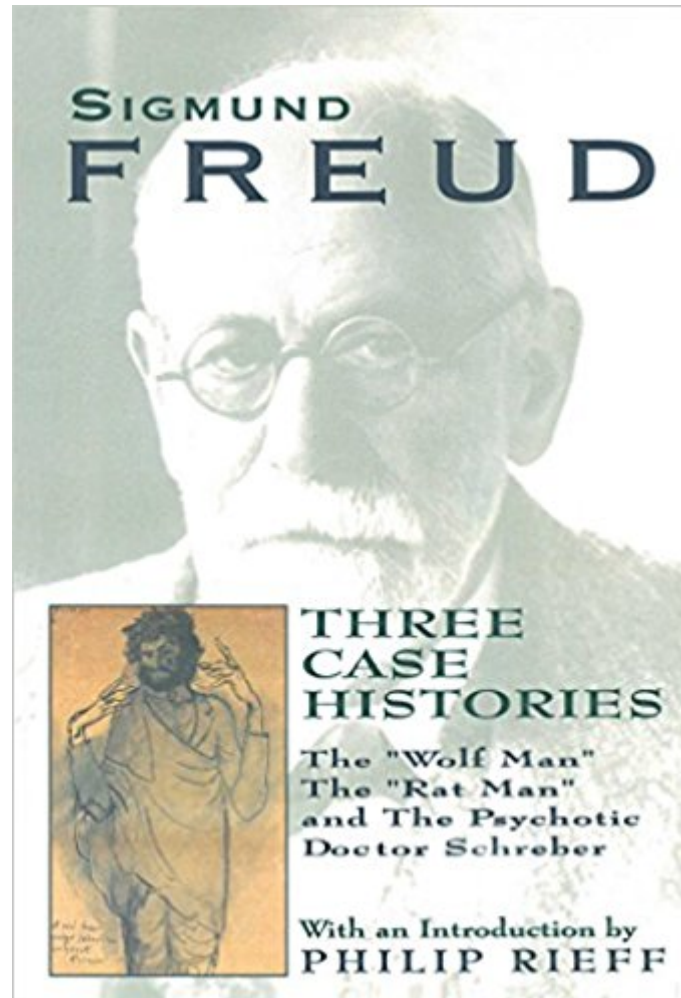

The book was written in clear language with no psychobabble or medical jargon. Here are some interesting things to be found in the book: 1: OCD symptoms actually represent repressed wishes to commit murder. 2: There is such a thing as a reverse Oedipus complex where a boy wants to identify with his mother and love his father. 3: The essential nature of psychosis is a regression to pure self-love. 4: Vladimir Nabokov based his book "Lolita" on a section of the "Rat Man" case history. 5: Peter Schaffer based his play "EQUUS" on "Wolf Man."
