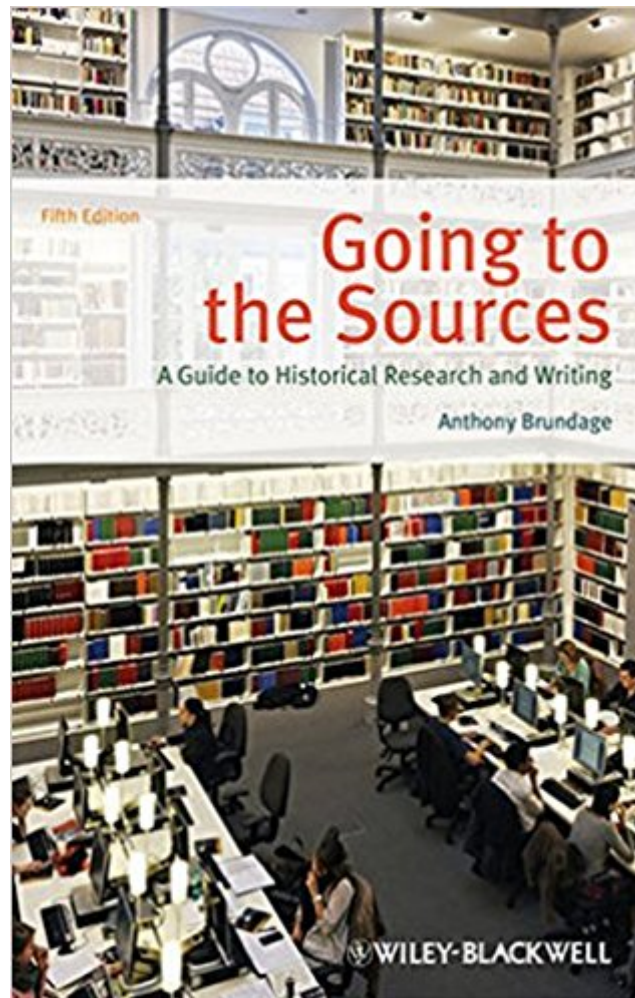

Appendices illustrate style for footnotes, endnotes, and bibliographical entries, as well as a list of commonly used abbreviations. Features a new chapter on the use of non-textual sources for historians, including a case study discussion of the historical importance of D. W. Griffith's film *The Birth of a Nation*. Addresses how to bring the critical assessment skills of reading to bear on film and other non-textual sources. Includes a student-written historiographical essay, with marginal notes for instruction.

My students found the sample historiographic essay useful. I had to supplement the method section with more examples of approaches, but still Brundage does the best job of any of the standard research and writing texts for history courses and in half as many pages.
