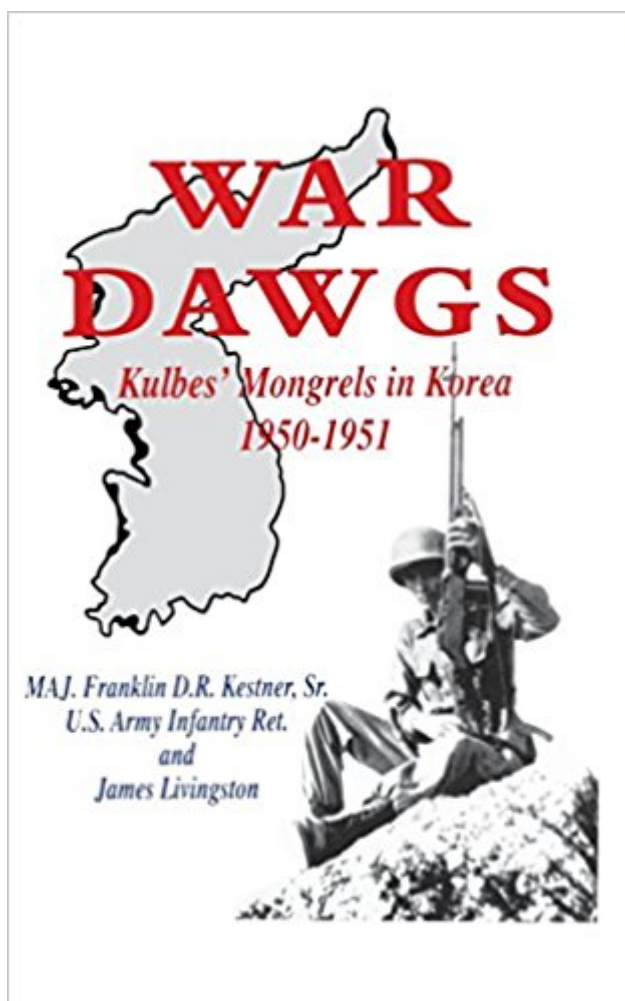




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War Dawgs: Kulbes' Mongrels In Korea, 1950-1951
