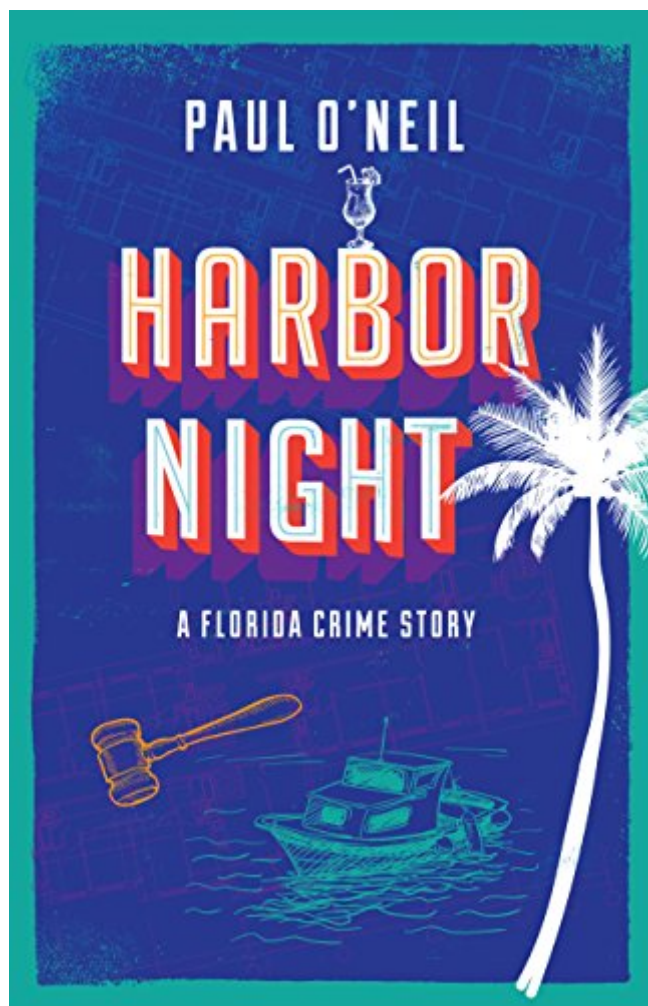


The book was found

This book certainly needed proofreading with respect to spelling and omitted lines and words. Otherwise I enjoyed the storyline, but thought some of the interesting characters could have been developed a little more.

First I've read by Paul Neil and looking forward to his second one. Good story and interesting characters. Enjoyed from beginning to the end.

Before you write another book, please learn how to spell. A VICIOUS dog is not a "viscous" dog. A scheme is a RUSE, not a "rouse!" It's a decent plot but the misuse of words and misspelling is distracting.
