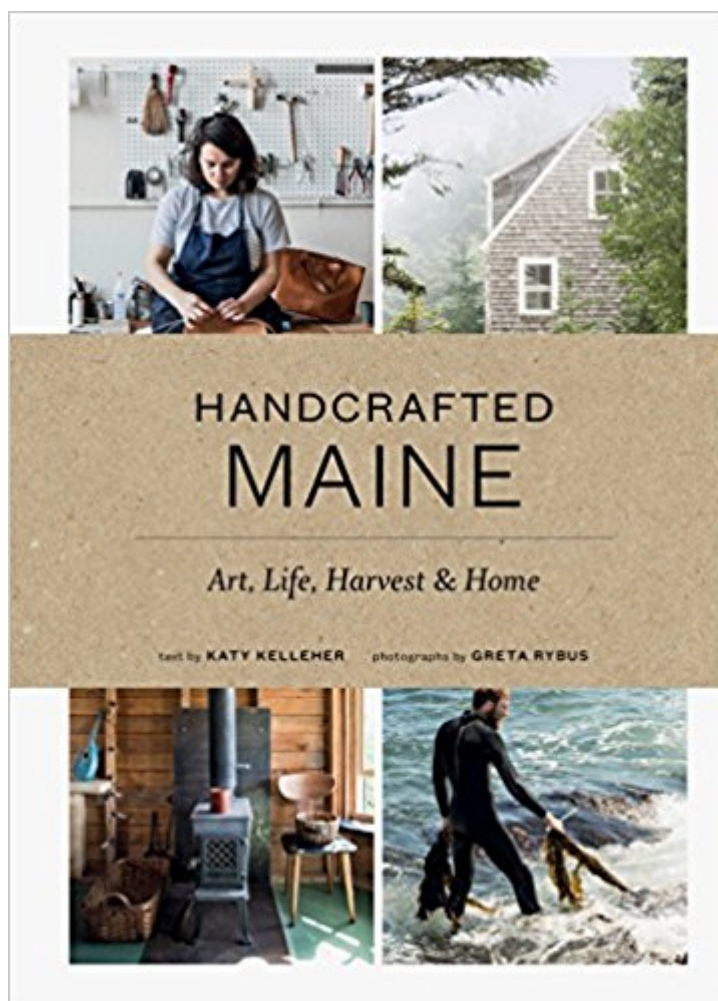

I love Maine and the artisans who reside and work there but this book falls short of a true tribute to handcrafted Maine
