

Robert J. McMahon received his Ph.D. from the University of Connecticut in 1977 and was professor of History at the University of Florida before moving to Ohio State University. He specializes in United States diplomatic history. He is the author of Colonialism and Cold War: The United States and the Struggle for Indonesian Independence (1981) and The Cold War on the Periphery: The United States, India, and Pakistan (1994). He is also the co-editor of the Problems in American Civilization book The Origins of the Cold War, which entered its fourth edition in 1999.

Reading all the original documents from the war has been really eye opening for me. There is so much propaganda around the Vietnam War, it is hard to get the real truth from anyone. It is barely taught in schools, and if it is taught at the anti-war American front. It's a really great book to read if someone just wants real answers. I marked off a star because of the book's price, but I have found the book to be very informative.

Very interesting reading for anyone curious about learning more about the Vietnam War. I bought it for a college class I was taking, have decided to keep it, because I enjoyed reading it.

For \$125, this text was an insult to my intelligence. First, it is a paperback, which should cost no more than \$20. Secondly, it massacres the Vietnamese language in names, quotes, citations by failing to use proper diacritics and tone marks as required by Vietnamese orthography. This is like writing an academic piece on Shakespeare but leaving out all the vowels when quoting the Bard. Thirdly, it does not contain an index. Fourth, it does not include footnotes or citations in the material included from elsewhere, which is pretty much the entire book's content. The editor and publisher should be ashamed to publish this text for any price, but at the price they charge, it is nothing less than the academic equivalent of highway robbery. I would give this text only 1 star, but the content itself, even with all the flaws cited above, permit me to reluctantly give two stars.

This book is ridiculously expensive because it is a textbook; know that upfront. This is not a book for people who are casually interested in personal study of the Vietnam War. It is a collection of essays written by historians alongside primary source material from the era compiled for use in university classrooms. Speeches, diary entries, letters, and government documents are all included here. All of the books in the "Major Problems" series of textbooks are formatted this way, and this one is exceptionally well-edited. The pages are made of heavy stock with wide margins, making highlighting and marginalia easy for the student. If you are purchasing this book for a college course, I hardly need to sell it to you because you have to buy it anyway, but you won't be disappointed in it. If you are considering this purchase for personal enjoyment, please understand that this book is not written as a narrative of the war's history. It is a collection, roughly in chronological order, of primary source material and commentary/essays written by historians divided into organized, sensibly-themed chapters.
