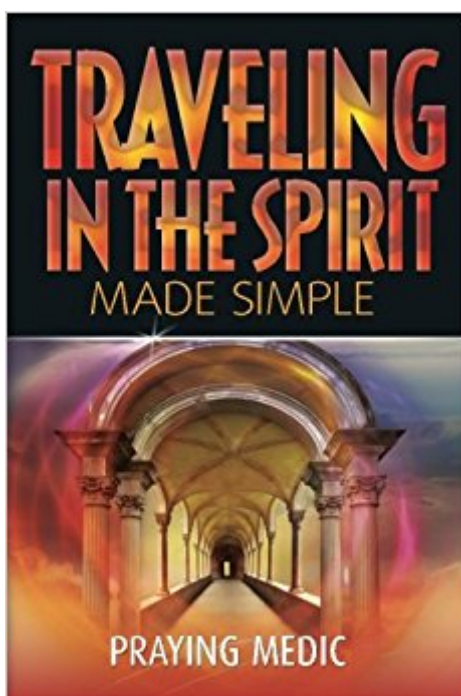


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Traveling In The Spirit Made Simple (The Kingdom Of God Made Simple) (Volume 4)

I'm a very open minded Christian, but I'm not sure even I feel comfortable with some of this stuff (praying portals into existence; intentionally having your spirit out there). Just be careful. I did enjoy reading accounts of events that some would call dreams or visions and others would call spirit travel. I did learn from this book. I'm glad I bought it, but I think I'll trust my own gut on some of this and say I don't feel comfortable with all of it.***** edited *****I finished the book so I could give an entirely complete review. I also needed to step away and prayerfully consider the book and how I should complete this review. I've also listened to the most recent podcasts from Praying Medic. I've seen PM on Sid Roth's It's Supernatural show, read his other books, learned valuable tips. I was a huge fan! The other Made Simple books were great, but I didn't feel comfortable with some of this. Knowing that the devil mixes truth with lies, I'm not going to ignore the parts I don't feel comfortable with. He released a trapped angel? Couldn't praying portals into existence be spiritually dangerous, and Biblically should we pray portals into existence in the first place? What about traveling out of the body at will whenever we want, just go up to heaven? It's not that I don't believe out-of-body experiences are real. I know they are because I dabbled in the occult before Jesus saved me. Perhaps my own past is what makes me question the topics and teachings in this book. Having dipped my toes into the mist of darkness previously, I do recognize darkness. This doesn't seem right to me. Not everything seems full of light. The latest podcast led me to unsubscribe from his podcasts, as well. I'm getting away from this series I once thought was absolutely amazing. I'm not changing my 3-star rating. Praying Medic is a talented writer, and I admire his ambition. I just think this is the last book of his I'll read. I want to stay on the right path, and I'm concerned this isn't it. The fact I cannot make peace with these questions, the fact I have wrestled with the question: "Is this 100% Biblical" gives me my answer. Be very careful. Research his guests and his mentors to see if their teachings are entirely biblical. Researching his guests, I also don't feel comfortable with floral

essence drops which open spiritual senses and bring dreams (because this reminds me of witchcraft) and don't feel comfortable with intuitive prophetic readings for sale (because this reminds me of fortune tellers).

This is an amazing book. It is a treasure trove of information! I feel that this book is more than a meal it is more like a banquet. As a writer, I have only had my own life as research and never actively researched a subject that I have written on, but *Praying Medic* shows us what a great book that can come from great research and careful planning. *Praying Medic* goes into many aspects of travelling in the spirit with a depth that has meat on it, and yet it is not too bogged down with information and research that it became dry like so many books. The result that we got in this book was a book where a novice to travelling in the spirit could learn heaps, whilst people who have participated in it to some respects could also glean from it. As a writer and teacher, I look at the quality of this work, its purposes and its objectives, and I see once again that this book was not rushed, or hurriedly put together, and it hasn't been written with an objective mainly of selling a book, but it is primarily a book that attempts to teach, equip and impart knowledge. Some people may have had a lot more experiences in travelling in the spirit than the author, but few of these people have been able to put together such an enjoyable, easy to read, conversation on this subject in one accessible place. I hold *Praying Medic* in high esteem and am happy to know him personally. As a person who has seen Jesus in heaven, visited my mansion in heaven, travelled in time and done some exciting things, I would say I am still a novice. Michael Van Vlymen and *Praying Medic* are not only great writers, but they bring us exciting topics and give us plenty of great stories to read.
